Artists will be chosen for the exhibit-the number determined by the size and variety of the work chosen for the exhibit. We reserve the right to make the selection based on the quality of the work first, and size second. Painters, photographers, sculptors and print makers are invited to submit work. A general rule of thumb is that each artist will receive approximately a 2' x 3' space in which to mount the work.

Work will need to be delivered to Theater for the New City on May 12 by 12 noon and will be hung that afternoon.

ARTIST AGREEMENT "2020 VISION SAVE OUR PLANET SAVE OUR COUNTRY" EXHIBIT AT THEATER FOR THE NEW CITY

You agree, if you are accepted into the exhibit:

- 1. Hold The Theater for the New City and any of the organizers for the exhibit blameless in the unlikely event of theft, damage or other loss of your work;
- 2. Help provide refreshment for the reception by donating either wine, cheese, bread, or crackers, fruit or crudités
- 3. Theater for the New City will take a 20% commission of the purchase price if a work is sold while exhibited at the TNC Gallery);
- 4.(a) Deliver and pick up of your work to/from the gallery at the prescribed times;
 - (b) Volunteer to help with one of the following committees:
 - Hanging Committee;
 - Reception Committee (food & beverage purchase, set-up/take down);
 - Design (card & poster (8.5 x 11 & 11 x 17 formats)); and
 - Publicity (outreach to press for coverage of event);
- (c) Volunteer to sit 2 two-hour gallery shifts at the TNC Gallery while the show is up;
- 5. Curator will make all final decisions with regard to the placement and hanging of your work.

All of your work must be delivered to the gallery (Paintings (edges can be taped or stripped), mixed media, prints, collage & photographs must be framed and ready to hang (including hooks and back wire); all sculptures must be free standing and stable or you provide your own plinth /stand); and picked up on the prescribed day.
- 6. Your work will not be accepted for the exhibit without receipt of one 8.5×11 color image of each work submitted, a 1 page artist statement that includes list of works, medium, & price and a signed / completed contract including list of works, medium, & price.
